NATURAL DISASTERS

Disease outbreak , waterpolution, armed conflict, drought, landslide, earthquake, tsunami, locusts, ice storm, flood, cyclone, tornado, hurricane.

A local industry dumps toxic chemicals into the bay.

Rain doesn't fall for a long time.

Swarms of grasshoppers descend, eating every bit of vegetation in sight.

A large destructive sea wave is generated by an earthquake or volcanic eruption.

Extraordinary weather conditions cause huge amounts of ice to form on everything, cutting off power, freezing water pipes, and causing road accidents.

Masses of rock and earth slip down the mountain side brought on by heavy rains.

Violent shaking is caused by earth tremors.

Damaging winds reach 125km/hour accompanied by thunder, lightning and heavy rains and sea swells.

A destructive, violent, whirling wind is accompanied by a funnel-shaped cloud. The wind speed at the vortex is close to 200km/hour.

Rotating winds bring a violent storm and heavy rainfall.

Due to heavy rains, the local river rises, flooding out all the buildings. Water has risen almost over the treetops.
